**KAERI MASU** non-past affirmative  
**KAERI MASEN** non-past negative  
**KAERI MASHITA** past affirmative  
**KAERI MASENDESHITA** past negative

**[Place] NI KAERIMASU.** I'm going back to **[Place]**.

eg. UCHI NI KAERIMASU. I'm going home.

8-JI NI UCHI NI KAERIMASHITA.  
 I went home at 8 o'clock.

BASU DE UCHI NI KAERIMASHITA.  
 I went home by bus.

**KIMASU** to come  
**KI MASU** non-past affirmative  
**KI MASEN** non-past negative  
**KI MASHITA** past affirmative  
**KI MASENDESHITA** past negative

**[Place] NI KIMASU.** I'm coming to **[Place]**.

eg. MOA NI KIMASU. I'm coming to MOA.

NICHI-YOBI NI MOA NI KIMASEN.  
 I'm not coming to MOA on Sunday.

6-JI NI MOA NI KIMASHITA.  
 I came to MOA at 6 o'clock.

**[Place] KARA KIMASU.** I'm coming from **[Place]**.

eg. KAISHA KARA KIMASU. I'm coming from the office.

FURANSU KARA KIMASHITA. I came from France.
